Famiglio, M.D., F.A.A.P is a physician, leader and educator with twenty years' experience leading academic affairs, most recently as the Chief Academic Officer for the Geisinger Health System. Dr. Famiglio created the Center for Continuing Professional Development, with Joint Accreditation from the ANCC, ACCME and ACPE for team based continuing education and develops more than30,000 hours of accredited courses each year.
