

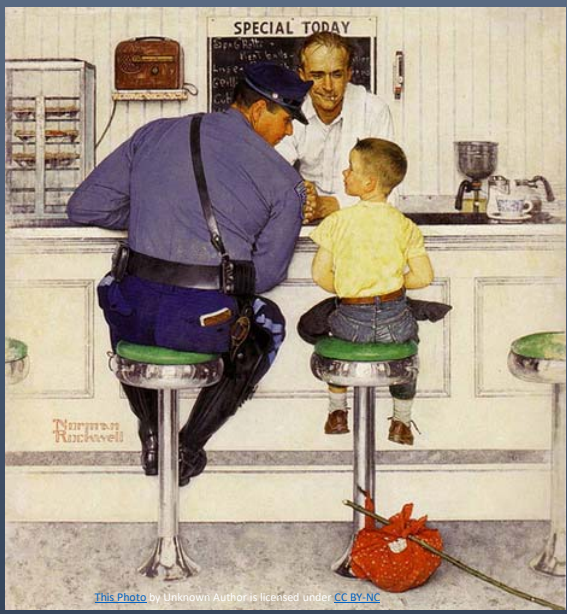

Physician's role - DURING

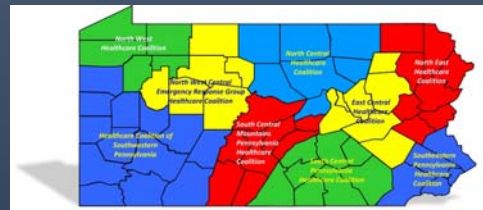
- Lead by example

Physician's role - AFTER

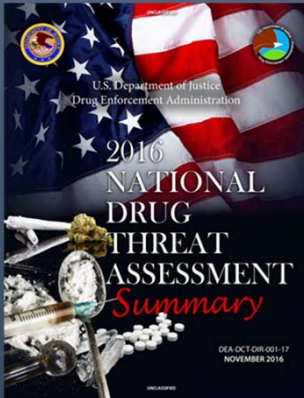
- Stress Counseling

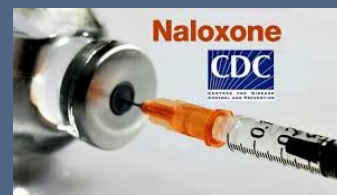
