



MEDICAL PRACTICE REOPENING CHECKLIST

☑ Prior to Reopening

- Construct a financial and staffing plan
- Develop and implement safety protocols
- Assess the supply of PPE
- Consider the role telehealth will play in reopening
- Update EHR for new codes and billing requirements
- Clearly communicate with patients about practice changes
- Be watchful of supply chain issues
- Review and update emergency preparedness plan
- Review patient consent forms
- Care for vulnerable populations
- Prioritize delayed care

☑ Financial Management

- Consider the capital needs of the practice and available funding sources
- Address accounts payable
- · Plan to meet existing obligations
- Develop a monthly budget
- Talk to vendors
- Tackle accounts receivable appropriately
- Verify patient contact and insurance information
- Analyze revenue streams
- Prepare for the new normal

☑ Staffing Considerations

- Right size physician and staff work force
- Communicate with staff about practice changes
- Review Human Resources information
- Provide refresher training for all staff
- Plan for absences and alternate coverage
- Consider options for vulnerable staff
- Give extra care and attention to the emotional and physical needs of staff

☑ Universal Safety Precautions

- Maintain physical distancing
- · Require universal face covering
- Implement strict sterilization procedures
- Continue to use telehealth
- Pre-screen patients for COVID-19 symptoms
- Preservation of PPE
- Establish a return to work policy for infected staff
