6 **WHEREAS,** Wallace Gilfillan McCune, MD, passed away April 28, 2017 in Whitemarsh, Pennsylvania at the  
7 age of 98; and

9 **WHEREAS,** Dr. McCune graduated from Washington & Jefferson College and the University of Chicago  
10 School of Medicine; and

12 **WHEREAS,** Dr. McCune practiced Internal Medicine in Northwest Philadelphia for 53 years; was a dedicated  
13 and active member of the Philadelphia County Medical Society (PCMS) and the Pennsylvania Medical  
14 Society (PAMED) for 68 years; served as President of PCMS in 1987; was Chair of Medicine and President of  
15 the Hospital Medical Staff at Germantown Hospital; was a Clinical Professor of Medicine at Temple  
16 University School of Medicine; was a member of the medical staff at Chestnut Hill Hospital; was a founding  
17 member of the American Medical Association (AMA) PAMED PCMS Hospital Medical Staff Section; and  
18 served as a Delegate to PAMED and the AMA; and

20 **WHEREAS,** Dr. McCune served our country during World War II as a Navy Lieutenant with a Navy PT Boat  
21 Squadron; and

23 **WHEREAS,** Dr. McCune was a true Renaissance Man, who not only was a gifted physician but an historian, a  
24 music lover, a world traveler, and an avid gardener who enjoyed life and was dedicated to his late wife, Fay,  
25 for 60 years as well as his family, friends, associates, and patients; therefore, be it

28 silence, recognizing our appreciation for Dr. McCune's many years of service to his community and to his
