7 **WHEREAS**, Rajendra N. Seth, MD, FACC, FACP, passed away on Saturday, June 24, 2017 at his residence
8 in Elkins Park, Philadelphia, PA, at the age of 78; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Seth was born and educated in India, receiving his MD from King George Medical College;
11 a degree of Doctor of Medicine in Pathology and Bacteriology from the University of Lucknow, India;
12 completed a Fellowship in Pathology at Philadelphia General Hospital; Residency in Internal Medicine at
13 Episcopal Hospital, Philadelphia; and was Senior Fellow in Cardiology at Philadelphia General Hospital;
14 Diplomat of the American Board of Internal Medicine; Board Certified in Cardiology and Vascular
15 Diseases; and a Fellow of the American College of Physicians; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Seth was a dedicated member of the Philadelphia County Medical Society (PCMS),
18 Pennsylvania Medical Society (PAMED), and American Medical Association (AMA); member of the PCMS
19 Board of Directors; Delegate to PAMED and the AMA; and Chair of the PCMS and PAMED International
20 Medical Graduates Sections, where he led the fight for the rights of all IMGs to practice medicine in the
21 United States; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Seth played an integral role on the PCMS and PAMED Membership and Public Health
24 Committees, where he raised awareness regarding the benefits of membership in organized medicine
25 for medical students, resident/fellows, and physicians, recruiting hundreds of health care professionals
26 to join PCMS, PAMED, and the AMA; and

28 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Seth was a proven leader in coordinating continuing medical education programs and
29 lectured and served on numerous committees and councils around the world, including most recently
30 the 11th World Congress on Clinical Preventive Cardiology and Imaging in Rajasthan, India and the 20th
31 Asian Pacific Society of Cardiology Congress in Abu Dhabi; therefore, be it

33 **RESOLVED**, that the 2017 House of Delegates of the Pennsylvania Medical Society observe a moment
34 of silence, recognizing our appreciation for this dedicated and excellent physician who was an active
35 advocate for his patients; and, be it further
