Assessing the Impact of COVID-19 on Outpatient Care

Rockpointe, in collaboration with the Pennsylvania Medical Society, developed and distributed online surveys to physicians and practice administrators in Pennsylvania

The surveys began online distribution in Pennsylvania on April 21, 2020 and responses are continuing to be received.

As of April 28, 983 physician responses and 160 practice administrator responses have been received

Practice Impact

COVID-19 will likely have significant negative impacts on private practices far beyond the conclusion of the pandemic

Physician responses (n= 983)

- 38% have had their patient loads cut by at least 76% since the pandemic began
- 56% report having the number of procedures performed cut by at least 76%
- 12% have closed their practice either temporarily or permanently; 18% are not sure if they will close
- Percentage reporting staff reductions of at least half for:
 - clerical staff: 26%
 nurse staff: 21%
 NP/PA staff: 18%
 physicians: 12%
- 50% are very or extremely concerned with the negative long-term effects of the pandemic on their practice



Telemedicine

Telemedicine is being rapidly implemented and appears to be generally well accepted by clinicians and patients primarily using general public social media outlets

Physician responses (n=983)

- 87% were not conducting patients visits through telemedicine prior to the pandemic; 86% are now, with 50% conducting at least half of visits via telemedicine
- Phone vs internet visits: 41% report at least half are through telephone, 39% report at least half are through internet
- 27% report telemedicine reimbursement as difficult or very difficult
- Only 6% of patients seem unfavorable to conducting visits via telemedicine

Practice administrator responses (n=160)

- Telemedicine sources: Facetime (31%), Zoom (22%), eClinicalWorks (12%), OTTO Health 3%, eVisit 3%, Skype 3%
- 28% reported having difficulty with reimbursement for telemedicine
- Only 9% report having internet connectivity issues for telemedicine visits

Government-Funded Financial Assistance

A strong majority of practices have applied for government-funded financial assistance during the pandemic Practice administrator responses (n=160)

- 77% reported applying for government-funded assistance for small businesses
- 67% reported having received an emergency payment/deposit from CMS

PPE Usage and Supplies

Most physicians and practice administrators report having a 2-week supply or less

Physician responses (n=983)


- 65% report clinical staff, clerical staff, and patients use PPE during operating hours; 19% reporting usage only by clinical staff
- 56% report having only a 2-week supply or less of PPEs

Practice administrator responses (n=160)

- Percentage reporting a 2-week supply or less for the following:
 - o N-95 respirators: 81%
 - o Gowns: 57%
 - o Surgical masks: 54%
 - o Hand sanitizer: 41%
 - o Disinfectant/sanitizer: 34%
 - o Gloves: 23%













Q6. What percentage of patient visits did/are you conducting through telemedicine?









Q9. For telemedicine visits, what percent of patients are using telephone vs. internet?








Q11. Estimate the quantities of PPE you currently have available at your practice for staff and patients.




Q12. How has the COVID-19 pandemic affected your practice staffing?








Q13. How concerned are you about the negative long-term effects of the COVID-19 pandemic on your practice?




Q14. How interested are you in learning more about the following aspects of patient management during the COVID-19 pandemic:




Q33. What county do you practice in? (Pennsylvania)




